Where? Currently we are Zooming. Pairs of tellers get to know each other via Zoom. Working on and refining stories is also done via Zoom, with the help of a coach if the tellers desire. The stories are then told on Zoom, at least for now.

When? Our first six sessions took place once a month, September 2020 through February 2021. Pairs are currently working on their stories and will tell them when they are ready. At this point, June and September are available.
